

## 2020 VAWG HG SERVICE FLIGHT PACKING LIST

1. Full Class A's blues uniform
  - a. Light blue short-sleeve shirt
  - b. Air Force Blue neck tie or tie tab for females
  - c. Service Coat- \*(3 button, new style coat preferred)
  - d. Blues Trousers (Trousers only, No skirts)
  - e. 2 V-Neck form fitting white t-shirts
  - f. 5 round neck form fitting white
  - g. Shirts Stays
  - h. 5 pair of Black dress socks
  - i. Corfam dress blue shoes (aka Military Low Quarters)
  - j. Flight cap with proper cover device with backing
  - k. Wheel Cap with Cadet Male Hat Device - (Vanguard)
  - l. Rear chin strap at back of hat
  - m. 1 USAF blue dress belt with chrome buckle and tip
  - n. Cap rank insignia with backing
  - o. Full set of ribbons with ribbon holder and backing
  - p. Name plate with backing
  - q. CAP cutouts (officer service coat)
  - r. Shoulder Boards (officer)
2. PT gear and civvies -
  - a. 3 dark blue or black workout shorts (no short shorts or sagging shorts)
  - b. 5 Gray PT shirts (CAP graphics only or plain gray)
  - c. Running Shoes (sneakers)
  - d. One pair khaki shorts (knee length) can be capri or pants
3. ABU Uniform (BDU permitted, ABU preferred)
  - a. ABU/BDU pants
  - b. ABU/BDU blouse with proper insignia and rank
  - c. ABU/BDU cover
  - d. 5 ABU/BDU t-shirts
  - e. ABU/BDU belt
  - f. Socks appropriate to the uniform
  - g. Boots appropriate to the uniform
4. Honor Guard specific uniform items and gear
  - a. Honor Guard cord (silver) if Enlisted coat -order enlisted Service coat cord from Glendale Parade Store -**SKU: 486MS**
  - b. Pistol Belt - White (Vanguard)
  - c. Short White Gloves - 5 pair (gloves with grips highly recommended)-
  - d. Ascot with Patch, centered and 3 ½ inches below top of neck band (Vanguard)
  - e. MK 1 Rifle with white sling (Order from Glendale Parade store)
  - f. Cadet Male Service Hat Device (Order from Vanguard)

5. Personal items
  - a. Tooth Brush
  - b. Toothpaste
  - c. 3 Bath towels
  - d. Travel size shampoo and soap
  - e. Deodorant
  - f. 8 pair undergarments
  - g. Water bottle or camelbak
  - h. Shower shoes
  - i. Brush/comb (hairnets for females)
  - j. Shaving kit
  - k. Medications
  - l. Sunscreen
  - m. Sleeping bag (cot is provided)
  - n. Pillow and Sheet
  - o. Clothes to sleep in
  - p. Washcloth
  - q. Personal Hygiene Products
  - r. Insect Repellent
6. Accessories
  - a. 1 notebook
  - b. 1 ruler for measuring ribbons, chevrons, and name plate
  - c. 2 black pens
  - d. 2 pencils
  - e. 1 shoe shine kit
  - f. Safety pins (for shoulder cord)
  - g. \*\*Locking box for personal items – Not mandatory, but highly encouraged. (lock up cell phones, snacks)
  - h. \*\* Bag chair for barracks (optional)
  - i. \*\*Fan – for barracks, (optional) has to sit on floor, no pedestal fans
7. \*\*Evening Snacks -(optional) No energy drinks be, mindful of allergens, like peanuts  
Ex. Chips, Granola, Apples, Oranges. No candy. NO refrigeration available.
8. All forms: CAPF 60-81, CAPF 60-80, CAPF 160, CAPF 161, CAPF 163 (160, 161, and 163 must be filled out, signed, printed out and carried AT ALL TIMES, especially while on details)
9. Contraband Items:
  - a. Tobacco
  - b. E-cigarettes
  - c. Alcohol
  - d. Illegal drugs
  - e. Weapons or fireworks
  - f. Energy drinks
  - g. All knives, lighters, or matches
  - h. Non-prescription drugs, herbs, supplements, etc.,not indicated on the CAPF 60-81
